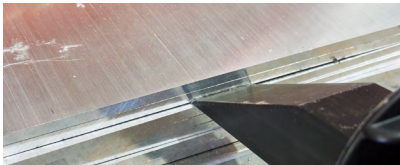


The Proper Way TO KEEP YOUR HANDS OFF IT™

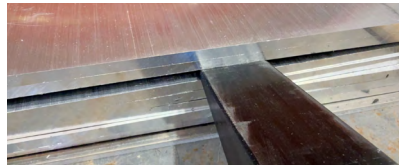
WHEN USING A WEDGEIT™

The WedgeIt™ is designed to safely separate stacked sheet and plate metal while keeping workers' hands and body away from dangerous pinch points. The user pushes the wedge head between metal layers, allowing room to insert spacers prior to lifting or handling operations. The ergonomic D-handle enables strong pushing leverage and comfortable control during separation tasks. Once inserted, the wedge can remain in place as a stable temporary spacer due to its flat ledge design.

HOW TO USE THE WEDGEIT HAND SAFETY TOOL:



Step 1: Align the WedgeIt at the sheet edge.



Step 2: Push the tip of the WedgeIt under the sheet(s) to be lifted.



Step 3: Continue pushing the WedgeIt between the sheets.



Step 4: Keep advancing the WedgeIt until a safe gap is created. Stop before the tool's hand guard reaches the stack to ensure hands and fingers remain outside the danger zone.



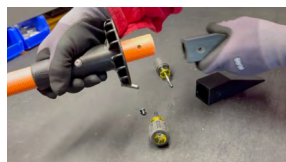
Step 5: Insert spacer(s) securely, then remove the WedgeIt tool.

HOW TO REPLACE THE WEDGEIT HAND SAFETY TOOL HEAD:

Head replacements are available for purchase to switch out following normal industrial-tool wear and tear.



Step 1: Loosen the screw to remove the binding post that secures the head.



Step 2: Pull the head off the tool.



Step 3: Position the new head in place.



Step 4: Reinsert the binding post and hand-tighten the screw until the head is fully secure.



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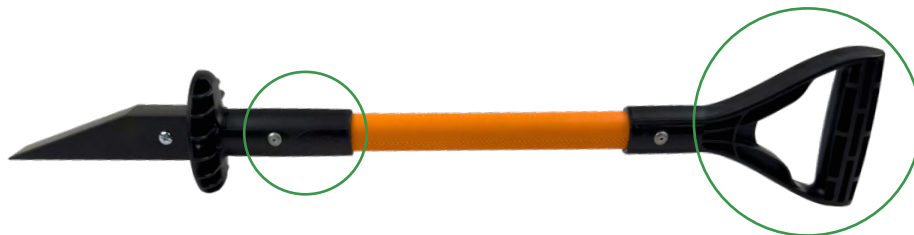


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PROPER HAND PLACEMENT



✓ DO'S



Always wear proper personal protective equipment as the job requires



Inspect end bolt tightness before each use

Inspect the tool before each use



Use both hands when operating tool



Stand with both feet firmly planted on the ground

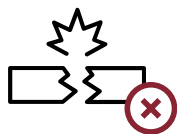


Keep hands behind the hand guard

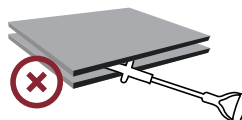


Clean tool after each use and replace head when showcasing significant amount of wear and tear

✗ DONT'S



Do not use the tool if damaged



Do not utilize the handguard to prop up the sheets or wedge between two items



Do not use tool while tired or under the influence of drugs, alcohol, or medication



Do not overreach



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
